



Types of HPSAs

Health Professional Shortage Areas

Provider shortages span three critical fields:

- Primary Care
- Dental Health
- Mental Health

Designations apply across geographic areas, population groups, and facilities.





HPSA Designation Criteria

To achieve a designation, the area under consideration must:


- Be a rational area for the delivery of services
- Meet minimum eligibility population to provider ratios; and
- Demonstrate that health professionals in contiguous areas are excessively distant, over-utilized, or inaccessible to the population under consideration.





HPSA Scoring Criteria

HPSA scores are based on a variety of factors and range from 0 to 25 in the case of Primary Care and Mental Health, and 0 to 26 in the case of Dental Health





Automatically Designated Facility HPSAs

Using the statute and regulations, HRSA has deemed the following facility types as eligible for automatic HPSAs:

- ✓ Health Centers (funded under Sec. 330)
- ✓ Health Center Look-Alikes
- ✓ Tribally-Run Clinics
- ✓ Urban Indian Organizations
- ✓ Dual-Funded Tribal Health Centers
- ✓ Federally-Run Indian Health Service Clinics
- ✓ Rural Health Clinics






What is the Source Data Update (SDU)?

 HRSA updates the datasets we use to designate and score HPSAs on a regular basis.

Census, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, ESRI ARC
 GIS maps, and Uniform Data System (UDS)

- Current data sets: 2023
- Not automatically applied to designated HPSAs
 - PCOs update/apply
 - HRSA NSDU





What is the National Shortage Designation Update (NSDU)?



- HRSA initiated update of Health Professional Shortage Areas and Maternity Care Target Areas
 - Includes Primary Care, Dental Health, and Mental Health HPSAs
 - ✓ Geographic, Geographic High Needs, Low Income Population, and Automatically Designated Facility HPSAs
 - Includes Maternity Care Target Areas
- Uses new source data
- Checks the three regulatory criteria and updates HPSA/MCTA scores
- Previews of affected designations released in the Shortage Designation Management System (SDMS) monthly starting March 28, 2025
- Anticipated run: September 23, 2025





2025 NSDU Update Preview Eligibility

Geographic/Population HPSAs

- Must be one of the following designation types:
 - Geographic
 - Geographic High needs
 - Low Income Population
 - Low Income Special Population
 - Low Income Homeless Population
 - Low Income Migrant Farmworker Population
 - Low Income Homeless Migrant Farmworker Population
 - Low Income Migrant Seasonal Worker Population
 - Low Income Homeless Migrant Seasonal Worker Population
 - Native American Population

- Must be in a "Designated"
 Status
- Must not be in a territory
- Must not be part of a withdrawal bundle
- Must not be designated or updated after the 2025 SDU* (Eligible created or updated between 3/21/21 and 3/15/25)





2025 NSDU Update Preview Eligibility (Cont.)

Auto-HSPA	MCTA
 Must be in a "Designated" status Must not have a supplemental data rescore that includes service area changes in an "Under Review" status Must not have a system data rescore or supplemental data rescore with service area changes completed after the 2025 SDU* 	 Includes all HPSA types including Medicaid and Homeless Must be in a "Designated" Status Does include territories

Exclusions

Designations Not Subject to the NSDU

- The following designation types:
 - Medicaid Eligible Population HPSAs
 - Other Facility (OFAC) HPSAs
 - Correctional Facility HPSAs
 - State/County Mental Hospital Facility HPSAs
 - Other Population HPSAs
- Territory HPSAs

 Eligible HPSAs on previous slide updated after 2025 SDU (3/15/25)








