

**Loan Limits**  
**Nursing Student Loans (NSL)**  
**Diploma, Associate, Baccalaureate, Graduate**

On April 9, 2020, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) granted a Decision approving the increase to the Loan Limit of the Nursing Student Loans (NSL).

After July 1, 2020, the NSL loan limits will increase to \$4,816 per year for students in year one and year two, and \$7,576 per year for students in year three and year four. Annual maximum limits notwithstanding, the aggregate maximum NSL that any nursing student may obtain is \$24,768. After July 1, 2021, the loan limits will increase annually by 4.277% per year as follows:
